Terms and Conditions for Food Vendors

If I am accepted as a food vendor,

- I agree to abide by all rules, regulations and requirements described in the 2022 Food Vendor Application Guidelines.
- I agree to provide certification of insurance as described in the 2022 Food Vendor Application Guidelines.
- I understand that my space rental fee cannot be refunded after July 8, 2022.
- I understand that the Festival does not carry insurance to cover my personal property and that I store equipment at my own risk.
- I understand that, as an independent contractor, I will be responsible for reporting sales tax directly to the State of North Carolina.
- I understand that the Festival makes no sales guarantees.
- I agree to buy ALL beverage products and ice from the North Carolina Folk Festival, unless I have been given permission to sell a specialty drink. Failure to do so will result in the Festival closing the beverage sales at my location.
- I understand that I am responsible for acquiring the appropriate Guilford County Health Department (GCHD) food service permit and that without approval, the Festival will terminate my contract.
- I understand that there may be extra safety precautions required due to COVID-19.
- I understand that I must maintain a separate line for staff/artists during the event. This line must be served quickly and take priority over the primary line.
- I understand that staff/artists may use script tickets as payment, for which the Festival will reimburse me.
- I understand that some food courts and stage hours will not coincide with Festival hours listed in this application, and I will be notified in advance if this will affect my vending.
- I agree to clearly post all menu options and submitted pricing at all times during the Festival.
